Our nurses are on call 24 hours a day and 7 days a week including holidays for any need that may arise.

At Floyd County Public Health/ Home Health Care we also have 13 trained Home Care Aides who are available to assist patients with many types of services. These services may include bathing, skin care, foot care, meal planning/preparation, grocery shopping, and other essential household chores such as vacuuming, dusting, laundry, and washing dishes.

Home Care services in Floyd County are funded by Medicare, Medicaid, Grants, Floyd County, and Elderbridge Agency on Aging.
