The Floyd County Veterans Memorial Committee has received approval from the Floyd County Supervisors to construct a memorial to Floyd County Veterans on the front lawn of the Courthouse. We are now accepting applications of Veteran's names to be placed on the memorial. Please fill out the form below and submit as indicated on the form. The initial cost will be a \$100 donation per name. Names may be added after construction but an additional fee will be assessed. Names of Veterans Killed In Action (KIA) and Missing In Action (MIA) will be engraved at no charge. Names will be placed on the memorial in the order applications are received. Any veteran born, resided in or otherwise having ties to Floyd County will be eligible.
