Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM by Dr. Lisa Kapler.

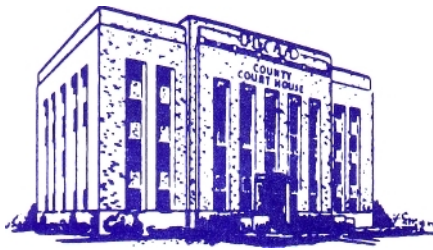
Agenda reviewed motion made by Rosemary Tobin to move item III. C. to II. A., with all other items remaining the same, seconded by Dave Tice, motion carried.

Minutes of the February 4, 2019 meeting reviewed. Motion made by Dave Tice to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Rosemary Tobin, motion carried.

Brian Hanft presented to the Board information on the Natural Resource and Outdoor Recreation Trust Fund and asked the Board for their support to urge legislators to increase the sales tax by 3/8ths of a cent to fund it. Jeff Sherman presented the Floyd County Board of Health with a Policy Statement: Funding the Natural Resource and Outdoor Recreation Trust Fund. Dave Tice made a motion to approve the policy statement, seconded by Rosemary Tobin, motion carried.

Gail Arjes, Floyd County Public Health/Home Health Care

YTD budget reviewed. The only concern at this time is UnitedHealthcare Community Plans and members changing plans which could affect reimbursement coming in. Gail and Kim are working with the Iowa Alliance in Home Care and other Home Care agencies on how to resolve this billing issue.

FY20 Local Public Health Service Contract reviewed. Floyd County's projected allocation is \$52,463. Contract Management Table was reviewed with the Board. Gail suggested that the agency use these dollars as they have in the past for homemaker, personal care, and skilled nursing. Motion made by Rosemary Tobin to use the dollars for the services listed, seconded by Dave Tice, motion carried.

Jeff Sherman, Floyd County Environmental Health

Year to date budget is at 66%.

Jeff updated the Board on the new round of sampling that he will be helping the lab with. This year they will be sampling for Bacteria (Coliform Bacteria and E. coli), Arsenic, Manganese, Lead and Copper. Jeff will also be advertising in the plat books for free well samples paid out of the Grants to Counties budget.

Jeff updated the Board on plans that he will be working with Gail and Lezlie Weber, EMA on completing an article for the paper on flood safety and flood recovery.
