Meeting called to order at 5:30 by Dr. Lisa Kapler

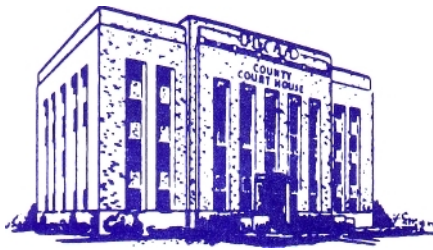
Agenda reviewed. Motion made by Dave Tice to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Scott Hansen, motion carried.

Minutes from the March 22, 2021 meeting reviewed. Motion made by Denise Pavlovich to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Dave Tice, motion carried.

Gail Arjes, Floyd County Public Health/Home Health Care

Lisa Koppin, Lezah Hansen, Carla Miller, and Mindy Waters presented statistics from programs offered by North Iowa Community Action Organization. Those programs include Maternal Health, Family Planning, Living with HIV, and I-Smile. Floyd County data was reviewed, and some data may be skewed due to COVID. Most programs were administered via electronic means and not face to face. North Iowa Community Action Organization plans to have face to face visits again beginning early fall of 2021.

YTD budget was presented. Public Health well within budget for this fiscal year. Various COVID items were discussed including ways to spend COVID related funding.



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COVID vaccination rates were reviewed. Two dose series initiated - 623, two dose completed - 5,325, single dose completed - 350, total doses administered - 11,623, percent vaccinated 36%. These numbers are for Floyd County residents. The percentage is all residents regardless of age and eligibility to receive the vaccine. Floyd County Public Health continues to administer vaccine at the Public Health office and will offer Pfizer vaccine to adolescents when allocated.

Reviewed HCA wage scale and HCA wage increases according to hours worked. Motion made by Dave Tice to approve the wage scale as presented, seconded by Denise Pavlovich, motion carried.

Home Health update given. Stacy Funte, Clinical Manager continues to do chart audits and meet with the nurses monthly to review chart discrepancies. This system has been working well. Also reviews the Quality Assurance Performance Improvement Plan focusing on Infection Control, no concerns noted.

Jeff Sherman, Floyd County Environmental Health

Year to date budget is at 65.47% for the year. No concerns currently.

Well and septic update - Jeff has issued only four well permits and 10 septic permits for the year.

Update on office help. Jeff introduced Jen Solomon as the new office assistant.
